Our nutrition team is currently seeking a **dietitian** to assist in the promotion of healthy eating habits to children through delivery of a nutrition education program in elementary schools in Northeastern New Brunswick.

Job requirements include:

- A bachelor's degree in Dietetics or Nutrition
- A membership in good standing with the New Brunswick Association of Dietitians
- Ability to give nutrition education presentations to children in grades 1 to 6 (i.e. Multizone)
- Ability to present comfortably in both French and English
- A good knowledge of DFC with an ability to respond to questions and inquiries regarding Nutrition Programs and nutrition issues
- Must have a valid driver's license as the position require some occasional out-of-town travel
- Must obtain a criminal record check prior to job commencement

This is a temporary contract working occasional days in the Bathurst and surrounding areas. The workload amounts to approximately 16 to 20 full days of work conducted between the end of September and mid-November. The candidate will have to attend a training session with a DFC member staff.
