

Motion 12.2 – Amendment of By-Law III Retired or Honorary Members

Amend By-Law III – Retired or Honorary Members:

1. Retired Members
 - 1.1 Member who has held membership in N.B.A.D. for a minimum of 5 years and who has retired from active practice of dietetics may apply to the Registrar for Retired Member status and be approved by the Board.
 - 1.2 The fee for Retired Member status shall be determined by the Board, and shall be not less that 1/3 of the active membership fee.

To Read:

1. Retired Members
 - 1.1 Member who has held membership in N.B.A.D. for a minimum of 5 years and who has retired from active practice of dietetics may apply **for Retired Member status and be approved by the Registrar.**
 - 1.2 The fee for Retired Member status shall be determined by the Board, and shall be not less **than** 1/3 of the active membership fee.

Explanation

Since the approval of By-Law IX – Duties of the Board of Directors to provide effective strategic direction and oversight using a hybrid model of governance in May 2016, some By-Laws and Policies need to be updated to reflect this governance model.

This is a By-Law that should be amended as the Registrar is able to make the appropriate decisions related to the membership register. As it is written in By-Law X – Registrar, *“The Registrar shall: Issue a certificate of membership in the appropriate classification upon written application, receipt of the prescribed fee and satisfactory proof of eligibility for membership.”*
