- Perform follow-up assessments of residents
- Maintain up to date diet profiles and assessments in Momentum for nursing home inspection
- Ongoing In-Service Education to Staff and Residents
- Participate in ongoing education and development to enhance knowledge
- Participate and be active in interdisciplinary meeting on residents
- Interact with and work with all Nursing staff and the food services department
- Assist with menu development twice a year to ensure adherence to Canada's Food Guide
- Follow the IDDSI diet standards
- Be available during mealtimes to feeding assistance, observing residents enjoy their meal or observe those with a history of swallowing difficulties – send referrals as needed
- Tray audits as needed
- Take an active role in continuous quality improvement
- Speak with the RN on duty for updates and read daily reports noting issues related to diet
- Relevant policy review and recommendations for revisions as needed
- Ongoing research in best practice nutritional services
- Attend biannual Food Service Manager and Dietitian Region II meetings
