By-Law IV	TEMPORARY MEMBERS			
1.	Temporary Members	1.6 A candidate that fails to pass the registration examination will be required to rewrite and re-register for the next available sitting of the CDRE. The candidate can practice dietetics under the direct supervision of a registered dietitian in good standing and a minimum of three (3) year's experience in dietetic practice conditional upon the approval by the Registration Committee. NBAD The Registrar will grant an extension for temporary membership with restrictions until maximum eight (8) weeks after the next writing of the CDRE. the results of the next exam sitting are known. If the candidate does not register for the next available sitting of the CDRE or does not practice within the regulatory guidelines of the Association, the temporary membership will be revoked.  1.7 In the case of a second failure of the exam, temporary membership with restrictions will expire immediately. The candidate must complete upgrading as determined by the Registration Committee prior to attempting the exam for a third and final attempt.
